Construction Bond Interest Rates Superintendent presented information concerning the recall of bonds. Board consensus favored asking consultants to appear before the Board to outline projections and costs.

Open Enrollment Request Superintendent presented the open enrollment request of Joshua Petro from Earlham to Adel-DeSoto-Minburn for 1993-94. Superintendent could not recommend the request due to lack of space in the special ed program requested. It was moved by Hjort, seconded by Heefner, to deny the open enrollment request as presented.
