Superintendent recommended new contracts for Steve Schlafke, head softball; Jonna Nelson, assistant softball; Shana Manning, assistant softball; Kaci Orton, middle school softball; Bill Shields, head boys' soccer; Troy Cortez, head girls' soccer; and Bryan Arzani, assistant high school wrestling.

It was moved by Hemphill, seconded by Flater, to approve resignations and new contracts as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

#### Open Enrollment Requests

Superintendent recommended open enrollment requests for Mallorie and Mackenzie Rooney from Van Meter to ADM, Mitchell Austin from ADM to Waukee, Dakota Worthington from ADM to Waukee, Lacey Calvert from ADM to Waukee, and Andrea Meyer from ADM to Perry, all for 1997-98. Superintendent recommended an open enrollment request from Laura Calvert from ADM to Waukee for 1998-99. #### Athletic Participation Policy

Board consensus favored the development of such a policy with possible modifications.

#### School Bus Bid
