Consent Agenda

It was moved by Bruce, seconded by Weems, to approve the items under the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously. Resignations were accepted from Erica Ritter, principal's secretary; JoAnn Sander, teacher associate; Vikki Schappaugh, day care associate; Amy Trotter, teacher associate; Marjorie Vaagen, media specialist; and Kathy Reece, music teacher. Pending successful background checks, new contracts were offered to Bertha Gil, teacher associate; Lindsay Steen, teacher associate; and Shannon Schuhardt, office secretary. Contract modifications were offered to Rikki Kuhns, principal's secretary, from .5 to fulltime, and Noele White, day care associate, from .38 to .94 time. The list of District Advisory Committee members was accepted.

Welcome of Visitors Open Forum

President Heefner welcomed visitors and invited public comments. Superintendent announced that Business Manager Shirley McAdon had received a certificate for excellence in reporting from the Department of Education for a perfect 1999-2000 special education supplement.

Elementary Roof Replacement Project Superintendent presented the RTI outline of the roof replacement project for the Adel Elementary School. President Heefner opened the public hearing. No comments were made and no written

comments were received. President Heefner closed the public hearing. It was moved by Bruce, seconded by James, to approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract for removal and replacement of the roof system at the Adel Elementary School and to set a special meeting for February 19 at 7:30 am to review bids. Motion carried unanimously.

Presentation of Grade 5th/6th Academic Program Teachers presented a review of the academic program for 5th and 6th grades. Discussion ensued.

Update on Good Conduct Review Process Principal Jim DePue presented a report on the progress made by the Good Conduct Review Committee. The Committee expects to present a framework for a revision of the good conduct code at the March Board meeting.

2001-02 Budget Review Superintendent presented an overview of the 2001-02 budget. The overview estimated a budget shortfall and actions to balance the budget. The overview showed a reduction in the cash reserve levy and a budget that would lower the grand total tax rate levy compared with the current year. Additional discussion will occur at the March Board meeting along with setting a date for a budget hearing.

Depository Bank

Due to the merger of Brenton Bank with Wells Fargo March 24, 2001, Superintendent recommended the completion of a new depository agreement naming Wells Fargo as the district's official depository bank with a limit of \$3,500,000. It was moved by James, seconded by Bruce, to name Wells Fargo the district's official depository bank with a limit of \$3,500,000 as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Review Classified Personnel Policies

With the decertification of the union representing the support staff, Board policy will again govern classified employees. Deleting references to the union and making some other minor changes were needed. Superintendent recommended the first reading of changes to Board policies 411.6 "Classified Personnel Transfers", 411.7 "Classified Personnel Evaluation", 412.1 "Classified Personnel Salary Schedule and Advancement", 412.2 "Classified Personnel Wage and Overtime Compensation", 412.3 "Classified Personnel Group Insurance Benefits", 413.5 "Classified Personnel Reduction in Force", 414.1 "Classified Personnel Vacations-Holidays-Personal Leave", 414.2 "Classified Personnel Illness/Disability Leave", 414.3 "Classified Personnel Extended Illness Leave", 414.4 "Classified Personnel Bereavement Leave", 414.8 "Classified Personnel Unpaid Leave", and 414.10 "Classified Personnel Serious Family Illness Leave". It was moved by Weems, seconded by Bruce, to approve the first reading of Board policies as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Administrative Reports

Superintendent announced the approval of open enrollment requests from Mark Mills from Dexfield to ADM, Sara Hayes from ADM to Waukee, Travis and Tyler Pullin from ADM to Dallas Center-Grimes, and k.c. and Anastacia Keller from ADM to Waukee, all for 2000-01, and open enrollment requests from Josh Cotten from Van Meter to ADM, Janelle Ehrhardt from Dallas Center-Grimes to ADM, Joseph Gilbert from Woodward-Granger to ADM, and Erin and Kaitlin O'Connor from ADM to Urbandale, all for 2001-02.

Superintendent announced that the City of Adel will seek an easement at the Adel Elementary School to locate a weather warning siren.

Superintendent discussed possible changes to the calendar for the current school year in light of the number of days already missed due to inclement weather. Parent-teacher conference days may be counted as days of school under state law, an option eliciting a favorable Board consensus. Other options will be explored.

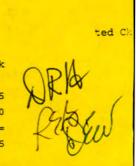
