Continuation of regular board meeting held December 10, 2001

Review Expenditure Reductions for 2001-02 Superintendent reviewed the circumstances of the reduction of \$223,000 in state aid for 2001-02; further budget cuts may be forthcoming when the legislature meets in January. At the November Board meeting, consensus favored making expenditure reductions where possible and where the impact on students and staff was not extreme; in addition, existing cash reserves would be used to cover the loss of revenue not matched with expenditure reductions. Superintendent presented a list of expenditure reductions as compiled by staff and administrators to be implemented. The Board was supportive of the listed reductions. In addition, the Board favored offering a choice of setting a fee to users before eliminating field trips or other activities that parents and students want. The link to a class and the cost will be considered for field trips. Out-sourcing some functions was also suggested for study.

Instructional Support Levy Resolution Superintendent reviewed information about an instructional support levy. Tax information was reviewed, showing no increase in the property tax rate if the cash reserve levy is discontinued. Discussion ensued. It was moved by Bruce, seconded by James, to consider participation in the instructional support program for a period of one year to levy an instructional support property tax not to exceed 3.5% of the total of regular program district cost for the budget year ending June 30, 2003, by resolution and to set the public hearing for January 14, 2002, at 7:00 p.m. in the High School Library. It was moved by Weems, seconded by Bruce, to amend the motion to read "not to exceed 5%". Motion carried unanimously. The amended motion then carried unanimously.

Review In-town School Bus Shuttle Service Superintendent recommended setting up in-town bus shuttle service on a break-even basis of \$50 per semester for all three towns. Reduced fees may be charged for those students who qualify for reduced-priced or free meals. Those in-town students who have received this service free of charge will continue without change through the end of the school year, while the service is expanded to those who were ineligible before, starting approximately February 1. Eliminating free in-town bus service will reduce expenditures for the next budget year while expanding the service on a fee-basis. It was moved by Weems, seconded by Hopewell, to set up in-town bus service in all three towns on a fee basis as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Review PreK-12 Guidance Staffing Needs

Surveys of staffs in the elementary schools showed a strong preference for continuing lower class size in lieu of raising class size to be able to add back a guidance counselor. Many teachers believed that classroom teachers were adequately addressing group guidance concepts while the district's social worker addressed one-on-one counseling and small group counseling. At the middle

Proposal for 7th Grade Baseball Program school, a retirement will allow two teachers to return to the classroom next year that are currently delivering guidance services; the district will advertise for a guidance counselor to replace them. A retirement at the high school will allow for the possibility of revamping the high school/at-risk program to study a Dean of Students system; there is no recommendation at this time.

add a 7th grade baseball program for Summer 2002. Middle school Principal Dave Elgin and Athletic Director Jerry Bond supported the program but could not recommend it due to budget difficulties at this time. Board consensus favored tabling further consideration until the January Board meeting when the issue of a second assistant soccer coach will be reconsidered as well.

Comparison of ADM and State Test Scores

Superintendent presented an article written by Curriculum Director Carole Schlapkohl comparing ADM's student test results to the state average scores. The percent of ADM students scoring at or above proficient is well above the state averages. ADM's commitment to smaller class size, quality staff development programs in the area of reading instruction, and Mastery Learning strategies in math supports ADM's efforts to increase student achievement.

Appoint Dallas County Conference Board Representative Dan Heefner agreed to serve as the Board's representative on the Dallas County Conference Board that sets the county assessor's and staff's salaries.

Review 2002-2003 Budget Superintendent began a preliminary look at next year's budget, state projections, and the procedure for dealing with a likely budget shortfall. Essential and nonessential functions will be examined and priorities set. Costs and impact will be weighed as decisions are made.

Administrative Reports

Superintendent announced the approval of an open enrollment request from Savannah Chance from Perry to ADM for 2001-02.

Superintendent announced successful grant awards of \$53,510 for technology to the Adel Elementary School and the Minburn Elementary School by Heidi Herold.

Board members Dick Bruce and Darrell Weems reported on sessions attended at the IASB Convention.
