Call to Order Roll Call The meeting was called to order. Roll call was taken. Present were Dick Bruce, Tom Hopewell, Paula James, Darrell Weems, and President Dan Heefner. Visitors were present.

Agenda

It was moved by Bruce, seconded by Weems, to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Consent Agenda

It was moved by Weems, seconded by Bruce, to approve the items under the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously. The FY01 audit was reviewed and accepted. Resignations were accepted from Teresa Adamson, child care associate; Darrell DePue, bus driver; John Erickson, MS football and wrestling coach; and Keri Zimmerman, elementary teacher. Pending successful background checks, new contracts were offered to Jamie McColloch, child care associate; Roberta Sergeant, bus driver; Bruce Stanley, custodian; and Barb South, MS softball coach.

Welcome of Visitors/ Open Forum President Heefner welcomed visitors and invited public comments during Open Forum. No comments were made.

Public Hearing on Instructional Support Levy President Heefner opened the public hearing to consider levying an Instructional Support Levy for one year (2002-03) in an amount not to exceed 5% of the district's regular program budget as published. The ISL that carries spending authority is intended to replace a cash reserve levy that does not carry spending authority, holding the tax rate steady. No verbal or written comments were received. President Heefner closed the public hearing.

Continuation of regular board meeting held January 14, 2002

Instructional Support Levy Resolution Superintendent recommended approval of the Instructional Support Levy Resolution to levy for one year (2002-03) an amount not to exceed 5% of the district 's regular program budget. It was moved by James, seconded by Hopewell, to approve the ISL Resolution as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Request for Additional Coaching Positions and 7th Grade Baseball Program

The Board tabled the request for a second boys assistant soccer coach and a request to begin a 7th grade baseball program from the December meeting in order to have more information about the budget picture for next year. However, the budget growth for next year is still not known. Discussion ensued. Considered were comparability with other schools, numbers of participants, cost, and outside funding for one year. While favoring both issues, Superintendent and affected principals and activities directors could not recommend approval but could support tabling the issues until the February Board meeting when the budget picture for next year and other issues might be clearer. It was moved by Bruce, seconded by Hopewell, to begin a 7th grade baseball program with the Summer, 2001, season, with funding to be provided by parents for 2001; Hopewell withdrew his second to the motion and the motion died when no other second was forthcoming. It was moved by Hopewell, seconded by Weems, to table both issues until the February Board meeting when the budget picture might be clearer. Motion carried 4-1 (Bruce-no).

Preliminary Review of 2002-03 Budget

Even though budget information is sketchy since legislative action has yet to begin and salary negotiations have just begun, Superintendent presented a preliminary review of the 2002-03 budget. Trends for state allowable growth and state revenue growth were presented. New money projections for our district and stay-alive costs were compared. A table of expenditures per student showed that our district is very efficient compared to other districts in the state; 94% of other districts spend more per student than ADM. If more revenue is required for a quality educational program, the instructional support levy could be used. More information will be presented at future meetings.

Hazardous Chemical Annual Report Business Manager presented the annual review of the district's compliance with the federal Hazardous Chemical Standard.

Administrative Reports

Superintendent announced the approval of open enrollment requests from Reyes Leyva from WCV to ADM, Nicholas Olson from Earlham to ADM, Kayla Pruitt from Waukee to ADM, and Tyler Sass from ADM to Waukee, all for 2001-02, and Jessica Farrell from DCG to ADM, Abigail Feller from WCV to ADM, Sarah Logemann from Earlham to ADM, Zachary Ostendorf from DCG to ADM, Kylee Deering from ADM to Van Meter, Taylor Gorsch from ADM to DCG, and Jacob Steelman from ADM to Van Meter, all for 2002-03.

Superintendent reviewed the progress of possible changes to the HS and MS guidance programs for next year.

Superintendent proposed procedures for 2002-03 budget reductions. For those that deal with personnel, input will be sought to be forwarded to the administrative team. Options will then be reviewed with the officers of the Board, who will make a recommendation to the full Board.

Superintendent asked the Board to review the timeline for using two days of Spring Break for snow makeup days. If more than one snow day occurs between now and Spring Break, two days of Spring Break will be used. The Board favored waiting until Spring Break before making the final decision.

Superintendent reviewed reductions in fieldtrips. There is some interest from parents to preserve some fieldtrips by paying a fee rather than canceling the fieldtrips. There also appears to be some outside financial assistance from groups that is available. Board consensus favored surveying parents to solicit their views.

Adjournment

It was moved by Bruce, seconded by James, to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously and the meeting was adjourned by President Heefner at 9:30 pm.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Iowa Code Sections 257.18-257.21 an instructional support program is available to all Iowa school districts, and,

WHEREAS, the Adel-DeSoto-Minburn Community School District Board of Directors believes it is in the best interest of the school district to participate in the instructional support program, and,

WHEREAS, the Adel-DeSoto-Minburn Community School District has held a public hearing on the proposed participation of the District in the instructional support program and taken into account public input,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- The Board of Directors of the Adel-DeSoto-Minburn Community School
 District hereby announces its intent to participate in the instructional support program.
- 2. The Board also hereby answers the following proposition in the affirmative: Shall the Board of Directors of the Adel-DeSoto-Minburn Community School District in the Counties of Dallas and Madison, State of Iowa, be authorized for a period of one year, to levy annually, as determined by the Board, an instructional support property tax in an amount (after taking into consideration instructional support state aid) not to exceed five percent of the total of regular program district cost for the budget year and monies received under section 257.14 as a budget adjustment in the budget year, to be levied upon the taxable property within the school district, commencing with the levy for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, to be used for any general fund purpose?

- 3. If, within 28 days following the adoption of this Resolution, the Secretary of the Board does not receive a petition seeking an election to approve or disapprove the action of the board containing signatures of eligible electors in a number of not less than 100 or 30% of the number of voters at the last preceding regular school election, whichever is greater, the Board shall immediately certify its action to the Department of Management and the District shall participate in the program.
- 4. If a petition with the requisite number of signatures as aforementioned is received, the Board shall consider whether to rescind its action or direct the County Commissioner of Elections to submit the question to the registered voters of the school district at the next following regular school election or a special election. At the election, if a majority of those voting on the question favor disapproval, the Board shall not participate in the instructional support program and if a majority of those voting on the question favor approval, the Board shall immediately certify the results of the election to the Department of Management and the District shall participate in the instructional support program.


