Teacher Evaluation System

Several members of a committee of ADM teachers and administrators, who have worked for almost two years to create a new teacher evaluation system that satisfies new state requirements and promotes professional growth, presented an overview of the new evaluation system. The instrument is structured around eight standards and 42 supportive criteria mandated by the state to lessen subjectivity and to provide documentation of good teaching, resulting in a comprehensive evaluation. This year, the new instrument will be used for all first- and second-year teachers and any veteran teachers who volunteer. Discussion ensued.

Administrative Reports

Superintendent reported that the district has been notified that the district has a first right of refusal to purchase the building in the default by the Adel Child Care Center to the Raccoon Valley State Bank through a subordination clause contained in the district's sale of the land to the ACCC in 1988. Call to Order Roll Call The meeting was called to order. Roll call was taken. Present were Dick Bruce, Tom Hopewell, Paula James, Pat Steele, and President Darrell Weems. Visitors were present.

Agenda

It was moved by James, seconded by Bruce, to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Consent Agenda

It was moved by Steele, seconded by Hopewell, to approve the items under the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously. Resignations were accepted from Roxanna Bennett, custodian; Jennifer Devine, assistant HS softball coach; and Barry Roberts, MS boys basketball coach. Pending successful background checks, new contracts were offered to Laurie Brown, teacher associate; Del Hoover, teacher associate; Crystal Mayer, teacher associate; Celia McCollum, sub bus driver; Jennifer Scott, teacher associate; Riceé Spence, teacher associate; Randy Tryon, EB Advanced Drafting teacher; Shelly Williams, MS girls basketball coach; and Mike Steele, assistant boys basketball coach. Transfers for Jonna Nelson from assistant HS softball coach to head HS softball coach and Owen Stump from MS girls basketball coach to MS boys basketball coach were announced. 28E sharing agreements and special education contracts were accepted. Dr. Barger and Dr. Palmer from Adel Family Practice were appointed physicians for students to obtain work permit certificates. The district will submit an application to continue to receive at-risk allowable growth funding. The district will continue to participate in the federal Title V program. The ADM Learning Center Handbook was accepted. Bids for a new school bus to be paid from PPEL funds will be let.

Welcome of Visitors/ Open Forum

President Weems welcomed visitors and invited public comments during Open Forum. Business Manager commended Lori Mann for her work on the fire-damaged portable building resolution with the insurance company. Student teachers were introduced. Vicki Kollenkark voiced her opinion that prom ought to be held in Adel.

Introduction of Student Ambassador Program

Pat Steele introduced Kevin Webber, the student ambassador who sat with the Board for September. One or two students from the HS government class will sit with the Board each month to learn more about the workings of a local government agency.

Resolution Calling Special Election on the Issuance of \$12,500,000 of School Bonds

The President stated that a petition requesting an election be called on the issuance of bonds in an amount not to exceed \$12,500,000 to provide funds to build and furnish additions to and to improve. remodel, repair and furnish the High School Building and to improve, remodel, repair and furnish school buildings in DeSoto, Minburn, and Adel had been received. It was moved by Bruce, seconded by James, to approve the resolution as presented and to set October 21, 2003, for the date of the election. Motion carried unanimously.

Contract Modification

Rambo and Associates The attorney was unable to produce a final draft of the contract with Rambo Associates in time for review prior to the meeting. It was moved by Hopewell, seconded by Steele, to table the issue until the next meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Canvass of Votes/ Organization of **Board of Directors**

Board Secretary announced the results of the canvass of votes. Paula James and Darrell Weems were elected to the ADM School Board of Directors for three-year terms.

Oath of Office

Board Secretary administered the Oath of Office to Paula James and Darrell Weems and they took their seats.

Selection of Officers

Board Secretary opened the nominations for the office of President. Nominations were received for Darrell Weems and Dick Bruce. Darrell Weems was elected President by ballot. Board Secretary opened the nominations for the office of Vice-President. A nomination was received for Dick Bruce. Dick Bruce was elected Vice-President by acclamation. President Weems assumed the chair from the Board Secretary.

Select Negotiation Team

Dick Bruce and Pat Steele agreed to serve on the Board's negotiation team and were appointed by President Weems.

2004-05 School Calendar Start Date To keep options open, Superintendent recommended approval of a request to begin school prior to the week in which September 1 falls if the district would decide to start early when it completes work on the 2004-05 calendar. It was moved by James, seconded by Steele, to make the request to the Department of Education as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Vote for Heartland AEA Board Member

Superintendent recommended casting ADM's vote for Ann Wilson, who is from Carroll and who is running unopposed for reelection for the AEA Board from District III. It was moved by James, seconded by Steele, to cast ADM's vote for Ann Wilson for the AEA Board. Motion carried unanimously.

Annual Progress Report

Curriculum and Assessment Director Maureen Taylor reviewed ADM's Annual Progress Report, noting areas of accomplishment and areas for improvement. Discussion ensued. Staff development will be supporting efforts to increase student achievement. The Board will receive periodic reports of progress.

Minburn Request For Sales Tax Revenue

Dick Bruce and Pat Steele met with an official from the City of Minburn in response to a request to "consider sharing some of the local option sales tax funds with the City of Minburn to use for police protection". The resulting recommendation from the two Board members was supportive of sharing funds with Minburn under similar conditions to those proposed in the previous 28E sharing agreement for sales tax, requiring the city to name projects and provide oversight from a committee to review expenditures. Discussion ensued. Due to the pending bond issue vote that would require the sales tax to pay for bonds with no increase in property taxes, discussion will continue in 2004 when the financial picture becomes more clear.

Discuss Procedure for Naming Athletic Facilities

Discussion continued from the last meeting concerning naming ADM athletic facilities. It was moved by Hopewell to name the stadium ADM Veterans Stadium but the motion died for lack of a second. It was moved by Steele to form a committee to establish a criteria and guidelines for naming facilities but it died for lack of a second. Board consensus favored the same concept, but not a motion, to direct the Board President to appoint a committee of representatives from faculty, students, alumni, veterans, booster clubs, and rural and city dwellers to gather community input and to establish criteria for naming facilities. Superintendent will invite suggested committee members to meet.

Administrative Reports

Superintendent announced approval of open enrollment requests for Cody Bailey and Justin Baker from Waukee to ADM, Mark and Nicole Beaman from Van Meter to ADM, Ashley and Nick Hofmann from West Des Moines to ADM; and Thomas Nowysz from Earlham to ADM, all for 2003-04.

Superintendent has honored reciprocal agreements with neighboring districts to allow open enrollment requests after the timeline if those districts do the same. Bussing requests that cross district lines are also honored by reciprocal agreements. Board consensus favored continuing the practice.

Board consensus favored looking for a replacement of the school pickup/snow blade due to its poor condition. A used vehicle will be sought.

AD DeVos provided some data summarizing participation levels of high school students in activities.

Long-range building plans were discussed.

Superintendent encouraged Board members to take advantage of IASB training and urged Board member to attend the IASB Conference November 20-21.

Superintendent presented ideas for special topics for presentations to the Board at future meetings.

A meeting of little league organizations is being held September 30. Superintendent will attend to begin discussions about relocating two softball fields due to possible construction.

Superintendent reported that bond issue presentations have been well-received, particularly because no property tax increase will be needed to pay for the new construction. The involvement and support of Board members in the presentations is welcome.

A special meeting to discuss the bond issue will be scheduled, probably for October 8 at 6:00 p.m.

It was moved by Bruce, seconded by Steele, to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously and the meeting was adjourned by President Weems at 9:50 p.m.
