Call to Order Roll Call The meeting was called to order. Roll call was taken. Present were Dick Bruce, Tom Hopewell, Paula James, and Pat Steele. President Darrell Weems was absent. Student Ambassador Melissa Mickael and other visitors were present.

Agenda

It was moved by Steele, seconded by James, to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Pending successful background checks, new contracts were offered to Pat Adams, MS softball coach; Amy Banwart, assistant HS girls soccer coach; John Begley, MS boys basketball coach and MS girls track coach; Ron Brenner, HS baseball coach; Chris Hatchett, assistant HS wrestling coach; Al Hoffman, HS girls soccer coach; Claudia Mestdagh, MS GATE teacher; Jerry Olson, sub bus driver; Joe Santi, assistant HS girls basketball coach; Bill Shields, HS boys soccer coach; and John Wesselmann, MS boys basketball coach. Transfers for Del Hoover from HS teacher associate to Adel Elementary teacher associate and for Kim Milburn from Adel Elementary teacher associate to HS teacher associate were announced. The district will make application for allowable growth for budget authority to cover the cost of tuition for open-enrolled-out students who were not on last year's budget count. The district will participate in the Iowa Drug and Alcohol Testing Program sponsored by IASB to comply with the mandatory drug and alcohol testing for school bus drivers. Vice-President Dick Bruce welcomed visitors and invited public comments during Open Forum. Cornelia Hoy had some questions about bond schedules; Superintendent provided her a copy of ADM's proposed bond schedule for the bond issue to be voted October 21, 2003. Principal Carole Reindl commended parents and many teachers at Adel Elementary for their participation in the Adel City Library summer reading program. Mike Mensen and others spoke of the benefits of a 7th grade baseball program and urged the Board to consider a program at the November Board meeting; information to be sought are costs, equity, comparability, scheduling, field availability, and number of participants. The Board received thank-you notes from many elementary teachers in regard to the professional opportunity they were afforded by the district to attend the regional conference of the National Reading Association held in Des Moines in October.

Character Education Report

Staff members Camie Walker, Dyann Kruidenier, Doreen Price, and Kim Timmerman, and Scott Raecker, a spokesperson for Character Counts, presented information about the Character Counts program. Discussion ensued. Studying the program is one of the Board's short-range goals for 2003-04. Research will continue this year.

Food Service Report

Liz Severidt, Director of Food Services, provided an overview of the food service program. Discussion ensued.

Review Physical Education Program Another short-range goal of the Board is reviewing the physical education program. Teachers Barry Roberts, Deb Kahler, Brian Moretz, and Mike Whisner discussed their ideas about what constitutes a quality physical education program and shared some of the activities and units taught. Discussion ensued. The next report will deal with strengths and needs for the program.

Future Educators of America Program Teachers Teresa Bellinghausen and Della Weems will serve as sponsors of ADM's chapter of Future Educators of America, whose purpose is to provide high school students with the opportunity to explore career options in education. The startup cost is \$100 for the FEA charter and materials. It was moved by James, seconded by Steele, to approve the sponsorship of ADM's chapter of FEA as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Discuss Option on Adel Child Care Facility

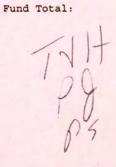
