Transfers for Jeremy Lord, ME teacher to DI teacher, and Steve Stanley, MS baseball coach to assistant HS baseball coach, were announced. The modifications to Board policies series 400 received the second and final reading. After being reviewed by staff, legal counsel, and the Board, modifications to Board policies 219.6, 401.4, 402.4, and 403.13 received the first reading. A grant for technology by Linda Burk was accepted.

Sally Bird left the meeting at 6:10 p.m.

Welcome of Visitors/ Open Forum President Steele welcomed visitors and invited public comments during Open Forum. Jacob Chapman spoke in opposition to the proposed budget for FY09. Business Manager commended the food service staff for an extraordinary effort to cover for two key staff members on sick leave during January and February.

Steve Meyer arrived at 6:15 p.m.

Public Hearing to Sell School-Owned House In Minburn President Steele opened the public hearing to consider selling the school-owned house at 628 5th Street, Minburn, Iowa. No comments were made and no written comments were received. President Steele closed the public hearing.

Superintendent presented a draft of an agreement with the City of Adel Park and Recreation Department for reserving gyms at the AE and 6-7 MS on a trial basis. Board consensus favored pursuing an agreement.
