successful background checks, new contracts were offered to Scott Geadelmann, coach; Devon Hawbaker, bus driver; Mindy Hatchitt, coach; Donald Hess, coach; Larinda Mongan, teacher associate;

and Joshua Schutte, van driver. A transfer for Mindy Hatchitt from MS softball coach to assistant HS softball coach was announced. Board policies 402.4, 402.4E1, 402.4E2, 402.4E3, 402.4E4, 402.4E5, 402.4E6, and 402.4R1 received the second and final reading. The district will apply for allowable growth for new open enrolled-out students for 2009-10, allowable growth for the 2008-09 special education deficit, and allowable growth for increased enrollment for 2009-10.

Welcome of Visitors/ Open Forum

President Canney welcomed visitors and invited public comments during Open Forum. No comments were made.

Graduation Rate Presentation Principal Lee Griebel, HS Counselor Doreen Price, and HS at-risk JCLO Darcy Simpson presented information on topics connected to ADM's mission. The HS's at-risk program was detailed, including a proposal to increase graduation rates by allowing ADM to graduate those students who finish the DMACC Adult HS Diploma versus the current practice that does not accept the DMACC diploma credits, causing the student to remain in a "dropout" status; the playing field will then be level with other surrounding districts that already accept the DMACC diploma. Further information was provided regarding current graduation requirements and the possibility of increasing credit requirements from 44 to 48. Finally, offering an "Honors" diploma for graduates that meet rigorous criteria and go beyond what is expected was explored. Discussion ensued. More information will be brought back to the Board in November.

Adequate Yearly Progress

Superintendent presented the results of the 2008-09 Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for the district and for each building. AYP measures student achievement as required by the No Child Left Behind legislation. ADM met AYP in all categories except grades 3-5 Math Total for special education students; if AYP in this category is missed again in 2010, ADM will be placed on the Schools in Need of Assistance (SINA) watch list.

Annual Progress Report

Superintendent presented the Annual Progress Report that is required by the State of Iowa to report state-determined indicators. In some ways the APR connects with the AYP but not in all respects. Possible changes to the at-risk program to increase graduation rates is related work to the APR and the district vision.

Comprehensive School Improvement Plan Superintendent presented the Comprehensive School Improvement Plan (CSIP) submitted to the Iowa Department of Education on September 15 and pointed out some of the more significant changes made.

2009-10 Professional Development and School Improvement Plans

Principal Carole Erickson reviewed both the district's 2009-10 Professional Development Plan and multi-year plan that focus on the lowa Core Curriculum and developing Professional Learning Communities that support teachers in efforts to improve student achievement. Building School Improvement Plans that are aligned to the high-stakes AYP and APR and professional development efforts were reviewed. Superintendent remarked that it is critical for the Board to have an understanding of efforts to align these processes from the Federal/State level to the district level to the building level to the classroom level and commended the principals for a great job on this work over the past year.

Administrative Reports

Superintendent briefed the Board on the 10% across-the-board cut to state aid to schools announced by Governor Culver last week and the impact on the FY10 and FY11 budgets.

Superintendent provided an update on the status of the H1N1 flu in the district.

Principals provided information about professional development on September 28 and plans for October 16.

Superintendent presented the agenda for the upcoming facility study committee meeting on October 15 and discussed the items.

Superintendent reminded Board members that the IASB Conference will be held on November 18-19. Board Secretary will register those that want to attend.

Superintendent drew the Board's attention to an article about Professional Learning Communities that provides insight into why ADM's Instructional Learning Team is studying this concept.

Superintendent reminded the Board that the Adel City Council is interested in holding a joint meeting regarding mutual interests in the near future.

Superintendent noted that it appears that the certified enrollment may show an increase of 13 students.

Superintendent drew the Board's attention to several calendar items.

Superintendent announced approval of open enrollment requests from Joseph Junker from ADM to VM and Arizbel and Vianey Lepe from ADM to Urbandale, all for 2009-10, and for Alec and Carter Goos from Waukee to ADM, both for 2010-11.

Adjournment

It was moved by Roby, seconded by Heins, to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously and President Canney adjourned the meeting at 7:55 p.m.
