Welcome of Visitors/ Open Forum President Canney welcomed visitors and invited public comments during Open Forum. No comments were made.

Set Public Hearing for Early Start Calendar 2010-11 Superintendent recommended setting a public hearing for the December 14 Board meeting to seek input regarding the option of starting school prior to August 30, 2010, should the Board decide to do so when the Board sets the calendar for the 2010-11 school year. Following the hearing, the district could apply to the Department of Education for a waiver to be allowed to start earlier than lowa code currently allows, as the district has in the part two years. It was moved by Heins, seconded by Book, to set a public hearing for December 14 at 6:00 p.m. in the 8-9 MS for the purpose of seeking public input on an early start for 2010-11. Motion carried unanimously.

Administrative Reports

District Enrollment: Superintendent provided an overview of the 2009 official enrollment, showing an increase of fifteen students. However, the trend line shows that that number is still the second lowest over the past 17 years. More detailed information regarding enrollment was also provided.

Food Service Report: Food Service Director Liz Severidt presented information about the food service program. There are three production kitchens and three satellite kitchens, serving an average of 1205 students per day. Severidt provided financial details and information about menu planning, food purchasing, and keeping records. Severidt also addressed environmental issues, state inspections, and state reviews. Discussion ensued.

Graduation Requirements, Honors Diploma Information: Principal Lee Griebel provided information regarding the proposed changes for graduation from 44 to 46 credits, beginning with the class of 2014. Griebel also outlined requirements for an Honors Diploma that could be offered. Discussion ensued.

Professional Development Update – October 16 and November 11: Principals provided updates regarding professional development activities for October 16 and planned for November 11. It is intended that the Board receive monthly updates and work examples from the professional development work throughout the year. Superintendent commended the principals for their planning and execution of the district's plan.

Professional Learning Communities Article Review/Video: Superintendent drew the Board's attention to the PLC article that was used to jump-start ADM's professional development this year and is foundational information toward becoming a PLC school. At the district Instructional Learning Team meeting October 31, a video on PLCs was viewed and may be presented to the Board at a later date. Board support of the PLC concept will be critical to success as the district proceeds.

FY10 10% Budget Reduction; FY11 Budget Forecast: Superintendent reviewed information from Larry Sigel, Iowa School Finance Information Services, regarding the state budget condition and the impact on FY10 and FY11 school budgets. K-12 education represents approximately 45% of the state General Fund. When the Revenue Estimating Conference saw a decline in state revenues for FY10, Governor Culver ordered a 10% across-the-board cut that reduced state aid to ADM by \$636,577. It is anticipated that the 1 1/2% cut for FY09 of \$114,211 and the 10% cut for FY10 will be brought forward to the FY11 budget and the federal ARRA stabilization money for ADM of \$567,559 will not be funded either. resulting in a deficit for FY11 of \$1.3 million dollars. Possible remedies include keeping a cash reserve levy in place, making cuts, increasing taxes, and/or using minimal reserves. It will be very challenging to construct a budget for the certification date of April 15, 2010, for FY11.

Facility Study Discussion: Superintendent presented the agenda for the next Facility Study Committee meeting for November 10 and an update on the committee's progress. A full report will be given by the ICAT team at the December 14 School Board meeting; Superintendent will then seek guidance from the Board to outline the next steps in the process of determining the most efficient use of district buildings that might include grade re-configurations and/or building closures. In light of ADM's drop in enrollment, the excess capacity of district buildings for students, and the state of the economy, the important work of the Facility Study Committee will help the School Board make budget decisions for FY11.

Open Enrollment: Superintendent announced approval of open enrollment requests from Tina Nicholes from DM to ADM, Madison Scroggins from Panorama to ADM, and Sarah Ramsey from ADM to DM, all for 2009-10.

Adjournment

It was moved by Collins, seconded by Roby, to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously and President Canney adjourned the meeting at 8:25 p.m.
