Non-teaching contracts were offered to Josh Barnes, assistant boys' basketball coach; Steve Cochran, assistant girls' basketball coach; Cassandra Mueller, assistant girls' basketball coach; Scott Geadelmann, boys' basketball coach; Donald Hess, boys basketball coach; Jodi Jensen girls' basketball coach; Todd Cook, girls' basketball coach; Nic Rasmussen, girls' basketball coach; Andrew Fecht, wrestling coach; Justin Schmauss, assistant wrestling coach; Scott Crannell, wrestling coach; and Chris Hatchitt, wrestling coach. A transfer for Grace Pettit from associate to office administrative assistant was accepted. The Board had the first reading of the 700 Board Policy Series, Non-instructional Services and Business Operations. The agreements for services/special education contracts were accepted. To help students who are minors to obtain work permits, Dr. Susan Donahue from Mercy Adel Medical Clinic was appointed to complete proofs-of-age certificates. Requests for open enrollment in for Jason Draman, 9th grade and Nicole Draman, 7th grade from Van Meter to ADM, Chase Seibert, K, from Perry to ADM, Kendyl Irwin, 9th grade, from Waukee to ADM, and Eden Wagoner, K, from Earlham to ADM were approved. Resolution for Interfund Loan: Director Roby introduced the resolution and Collins seconded to approve the interfund loan from the General Fund to the PPEL Fund in the amount of \$40,000 to bear interest at the rate of .25% and such interfund loan is to be repaid to the General Fund with interest upon receipt of property taxes. Motion carried unanimously.

Change Order No.2: It was moved by Book, seconded by Roby to approve the change order of \$315 to add an exit light outside the new classroom for GTT and Science. Motion carried unanimously.

Change Order No.3: It was moved by Banwart, seconded by Collins to approve the change order of a credit for the fire sprinkler work of \$4,449 for the new classroom for GTT and Science. Motion carried unanimously.

This remodel will square off the wrestling room. It is currently in an odd shape and requires a custom-cut wrestling mat. Motion carried unanimously.

The significance of the ACT at the state level appears to be growing. Director Jason Glass has spoken of requiring all lowa graduates to take the ACT.

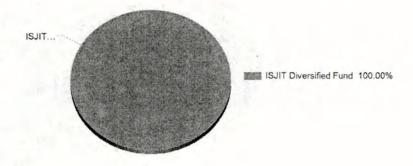

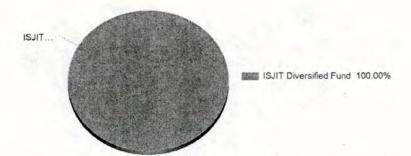

RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERFUND LOAN

WHEREAS, the School District is in need of funds to cover anticipated deficiencies in the PPEL Fund:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ADEL DESOTO MINBURN COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT OF DALLAS COUNTY, IOWA:

Section 1. That the Treasurer be authorized to transfer moneys from the General Fund to the PPEL fund, such transfer to be in the amount of \$40,000 to bear interest at the rate of .25% and such interfund loan is to be repaid to the General Fund with interest upon receipt of property taxes. This interfund loan must be repaid by December 31, 2012.

Section 2. That in the event that the District is unable to repay the interfund loan by October 1, 2013, the District shall proceed under the provisions of lowa Code chapter 74 to issue an anticipatory warrant or, as applicable, seek approval of the voters pursuant to lowa code section 278.1(5) for transfer of surplus funds from the debt service, capital projects to the general fund, or, for other transfers, seek approval from the state appeal board pursuant to lowa Code section 24.223.
