Alton School District Truancy Guidelines

In an effort to provide your child with the greatest opportunity for success, please find the reminder of the Truancy Guidelines below and the importance of school attendance.

- 1. Regular attendance is CRUCIAL to every student's success.
- 2. It is important that your student be at school on time. This does not mean dropping your child off right at the time school starts or after. Being late means your child is missing important instructional time.
- 3. Please be proactive in calling your students' school to report an absence. Schools request a phone call before 9:00 am on the day of absence.
- 4. Please refer to your Alton School District calendar (pages 15 & 16) for the guidelines concerning excused and unexcused absences. A copy of the calendar is also available at altonschools.org.

If you take your student to the clinic, doctor, or emergency room, please ask for a signed excuse. The excused slip should be sent to school with your child on the day of their return. Medical offices can also fax it to (618) 463-2121.
