IAR Testing

IAR is the required state test we will be taking the first week in April. Our testing window is Monday, April 4 - Thursday, April 14. It is very important that your child is at school and on for the testing session. We will be starting in the morning, and once the testing session has started no one will be able to enter the testing room until the testing session is complete.

Alton School District #11 Truancy Guidelines

In an effort to provide your child with the greatest opportunity for success, please find a reminder of our Truancy Guidelines below and the importance of school attendance. Our day starts at 8 am and we dismiss at 2:25 pm.

- 1. Regular attendance is crucial to every student's success.
- 2. It is important that your child be to school on time. This does not mean dropping your child off right at the time school starts or after. Being late means your child is missing important instructional time.
- 3. Please be proactive in calling your student's school to report absences. Schools request that you please call before 9 am on the day of the absence.
- 4. Please refer to your Alton School District calendar (page 15 & 16) for guidelines concerning excused and unexcused absences. A copy of the calendar is also available online at altonschools.org.

If you take your student to the clinic, doctor, or the emergency room, please ask for a signed excuse. The excused slip should be sent to school with your child on the day they return. Medical offices can also fax it to (618) 463-2121.

COVID Update

Following the JCAR vote to reject the extension of the Illinois emergency regulations for masking students and staff and exclusion of close contacts can only occur through court order or an order from the Madison County Health Department. Starting February 16, we moved to masks strongly recommended for our students and staff, but not required. Please note that masks are no longer required while on public buses. On Friday, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) announced that they will no longer require students or staff to wear masks while riding on public school buses. We will still be offering optional weekly COVID screenings in the schools. Please note that if your child is participating in the weekly screenings they will need to wear a mask while they are in the testing area.
