We want to ensure that our students are safe at all times. If your child is going to be absent for any reason, please notify the school (463-2130). If we have not received a call, you will be contacted to confirm the absence.

COVID related absences:

If your child is ill and is out for isolation and/or quarantine your child's absence will be excused. Instructional supports, related services, and assignments will be provided to students. When your child is going to be out for this reason, please contact the teacher for assignments and work that they need. If your child will need a hotspot or Chromebook please let the teacher know and we will have one available to use while your child is out.

Visiting the Building

Building doors remain locked at all times for the safety and protection of our students and staff. All visitors must be buzzed in through the front doors and report to the office to sign in and receive a visitor pass.

<u>Transportation Changes</u>

Anytime you need to make a change in transportation, please contact the main office at 463-2130. To ensure the safety of our students, family members will not be required to contact the school before 11:00 am to make a change to their child's transportation for the school day. Should families encounter an unexpected emergency after this time on a given day, please call the school to discuss other transportation arrangements. Thanks for understanding as we work to ensure the safest dismissal and transportation process possible.

Parent Drop-Off

Students should not be dropped off before 7:30 am. Please do not drop students prior as there is no supervision before 7:30 am. If you would like your child to eat breakfast at school, please make sure they arrive by 7:55 am. Breakfast will not be served after 8:00 am. At 8:00 am the doors in the gym lobby will be closed, so staff can move to their class. If your child arrives after 8:00 am, please drop them at the main lobby doors. This will ensure they can eat and make it to class on time. When dropping off students in the circle drive please make sure to unload in the area between the light poles in front of the gym lobby doors. Vehicles need to stay in a single file line for the safety of the students. Please do not pass other cars. Please be courteous of the time it takes to unload your students. Thank you for your cooperation.

Parent Pick-Up

Parents picking up students by car will receive a hang tag that is numbered and corresponds with name(s) of child(ren) being picked up. After school, parents and guardians will need to pull around to the back of the building for parent pick-up. Please do not arrive prior to 1:45pm. Please remain in your car and pull up to the door, which is located toward the building side of the second parking lot. Please wait in line until your child(ren) are escorted to your vehicle by the supervisor on duty. Additional hang tags can be requested if you would like to give permission to someone to pick up your child from school.

Students are allowed to bring treats to share with their classmates this year. Please let the classroom teacher know that you will be sending them. They also must be store bought.
