Parent/Visitor Code of Conduct

The primary purpose of our code of conduct is to ensure a safe and orderly school for our students, staff and parents. The Code of Conduct sets the parameters to maintain a civil, peaceful and constructive environment between adults. The following behaviors are not allowed when visiting our campus:

- The use of profanity, yelling or making derogatory comments
- Arguing between adults with or without the intention to cause physical injury
- Threatening staff, parents or other members of the school community
- Aggressive behaviors against all persons, property, or possessions
- The use of social media, text or email to threaten, demean, and or to bully another adult

The behaviors above are examples and non inclusive. These types of behaviors will be considered "willful disruption of the orderly operation of the school," which is in violation of Penal Code §626.4 which states:


"The chief administrative officer of a campus...or a school...may notify a person that consent to remain on the campus or other facility under the control of the chief administrative officer has been withdrawn whenever there is reasonable cause to believe that such person has willfully disrupted the orderly operation of such campus or facility." Further violation of Penal Code §626.4 may result in the commission of a misdemeanor.

Additionally, the actions and behaviors above would be considered a violation of Education Code §44811 which states:

"Any parent, guardian, or other person whose conduct in a place where a school employee is required to be in the course of his or her duties materially disrupts classwork or extracurricular activities or involves substantial disorder is guilty of a misdemeanor."

A violation to this section of the Education Code may result in a fine of not less \$500 and not more than \$1000.

Such behaviors may result in the removal of the adult from campus by the police and will result in being barred from coming to campus indefinitely.



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Código de Conducta

El propósito del código de conducta es para asegurar un ambiente escolar seguro y ordenado para nuestros estudiantes, empleados y padres. El código de conducta delinea parámetros para mantener un ambiente civil, pacífico y constructivo entre adultos. Los siguientes comportamientos no se permiten en nuestro plantel escolar:

- Uso de groserías, gritos o comentarios de degradación a otros
- Alegatos entre adultos con o sin intención de causar daño físico
- Amenazas a los empleados escolares, padres o miembros del PTA
- Comportamientos agresivos contra personas, propiedad o posesiones
- Uso de medios sociales, textos o correo electrónico para amenazar a otros adultos

Estos comportamientos mencionados se considerarán “interrupción, a propósito, de la operación ordenada de la escuela,” lo cual es violación al Código Penal §626.4 que dice:

“El administrador principal de la escuela puede notificar a una persona que el permiso para estar en la escuela u otro establecimiento bajo el control del administrador principal ha sido revocado cuando hay causa razonable de creer que tal persona a interrumpido, a propósito, la operación ordenada de tal escuela o establecimiento.” La continua violación del Código Penal §626.4 puede resultar en la comisión de un delito menor.

En adición, las acciones y comportamientos arriba se consideran una violación al Código de Educación §44811 que dice:

“Cualquier parent, guardián u otra persona cuya conducta en un lugar donde un empleado escolar se requiere estar en el transcurso de sus deberes interrumpe materialmente las actividades de clase o extracurriculares o implica desorden substancial es culpable de un delito menor.”

La violación a esta sección del Código de Educación puede resultar en una multa no menos de \$500 y no más de \$1000.

Tales conductas pueden resultar en remover al adulto del plantel escolar por la policía y serle negado el poder estar en el plantel escolar indefinidamente.
