

# What to Expect at School This Year

- We are prepared and looking forward to supporting your child by providing the best education possible
  - We will continue to focus on connecting with our students and having fun doing it!
  - It will be critical that your child is on-time and present every day, every period
- We have work ahead of us and it will take teamwork
  - We want to partner with you to ensure your child has the most meaningful and positive educational experience at our school
- The single most important thing as a parent, is make sure your child is at school every day.

# Over 40 years of research has confirmed the impact of school attendance on educational achievement

- **Attendance is the number one predictor** of dropout and graduation rates
- 17% Only 17% of chronically absent students in kindergarten and 1st grade can read on grade level- that's just 2 days a month!
- There is a 25% drop in likelihood of graduating high school in 4 years when students are absent between 5-9 days per semester
- As little as 5-9 absences a semester can drop a student's GPA from a 3.0 to a 2.7

### We Want to See Your Child Every Day

#### Did you know in Secondary School

For Secondary Schools

- By 6th grade, absenteeism is one of three signs that a student may drop out of high school.
- By 9th grade, attendance is a better predictor of graduation rates than 8th grade test scores.
- Frequent absences can be a sign that a student is losing interest in school, struggling with school work, dealing with a bully or facing some other difficulty. We can help!
- Missing 10%, or 2 days a month, over the course of the school year, can affect a student's academic success.
- As little as 5-9 absences a semester can drop a student's GPA from a 3.0 to a 2.7

Being on time and present every day will be a skill that will help them succeed in high school, college and beyond.

# First Things, First

- Aeries App
  - IMPORTANT: Check your child's assignments, grades and attendance often
- ParentSquare
  - To receive absence notifications, verify reason for absence, communicate directly with your child's teacher
- Your Current and Correct Contact Information
  - Do we have your current contact information including phone number, email and address?
  - Any changes in e-mail address and/or phone number should be made directly to our office.
  - Address changes will need to be submitted to our office staff

### The Law

A pupil subject to compulsory full-time education or to compulsory continuation education who is

- absent from school without a valid excuse three full days in one school year or
- tardy or absent for more than a 30-minute period during the school day without a valid excuse on three occasions in one school year,
- or any combination thereof,

shall be classified as a truant and shall be reported to the attendance supervisor or to the superintendent of the school district.

### When Your Child Needs to Miss School

#### Call the school on the day of an absence (as soon as possible) to report

- Confirm reason in detail; our school is obligated to ensure your student is safe
- If the absence has not been previously cleared by phone or email, the student must submit a written note signed by the parent/guardian to the office
- A note or doctor's note is required within 3 days of the student returning to school
  - When a phone call or note is not received, your student will be marked as "unexcused"
- If you receive a notification that your child was marked absent, you can submit your note using the "Parent Square" Please confirm reason for student missing school that day.

### **Types of Absences**

#### **Examples of EXCUSED absences**

- Illness or injury of the student, which necessitates the absence of the student, including COVID related illness or quarantine
- Medical or dental appointment; please bring note from doctor
- Attendance at the funeral of an immediate family member
- Appearance in court
- Observance of holiday or ceremony of his/her religion
- Family Emergency

#### **Examples of UNEXCUSED absences:**

- Vacations extending beyond school breaks
- Over-sleeping
- Traffic delays
- Car not working
- Keeping student home to watch siblings
- Unverified absences

### Final Thoughts...

- The single most important thing a parent can do is make sure your child is at school every day.
  - Regular School Attendance is the number one predictor of student success

#### Reminders & Tips:

- Establish or re-establish a routine to ensure your child is on time and present everydayevery minute counts
- Talk about school in a positive way, ask your child questions about their school day
- Your student should remain at home if they are ill, contact your school as soon as possible
- Avoid scheduling doctor/dental appointments during school hours whenever possible
- Although tempting, don't schedule or extend vacations when your child will miss valuable learning time.
- Reach out for help if/when you or your child need it.
