


iO Assessment 101 - Creating Item Bank Tests (Basic)

This tutorial will help you build a test using whichever item bank(s) your district has purchased. You can also add the items/questions YOU created yourself by choosing your respective district's item bank.






Default Target Test Level:

Choose the grade level.

For Test Name, notice the suggested name that appears based on your initials and what you selected above. You will still need to append a description (just click within the brackets to do so).



Add a Short Name because long names don't fit on reports. Often you can simply cut and paste your test name here.

If you see that an item you like is associated with a passage, you can view ALL the items associated with that passage. To do so:

- 1. Change your **Standard** back to **Any**.
- 2. Click the **Passage** menu and select the one you want.
- 3. Click Show Items/Questions.

Go through and add more items as described above. When done, click **Go to Step 2** at the top right of your screen





Step 2 allows you to preview the test. If you want to change the order of your questions, look along the left side your page. Click-hold-drag each question to the position you want. Then click **Update Item Order.** Note: Since questions on online tests are shuffled by default, updating the order here will only affect hardcopy versions and how they are listed in reports later on.

When satisfied, click Save & Finish.
