
Step 1 - Click on Reports > Group Reports > Report Builder



Step 2 - Set your enrollment data.



Step 3 - Start with getting data for one grade at a time.





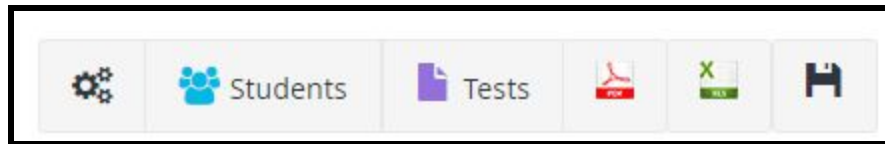
