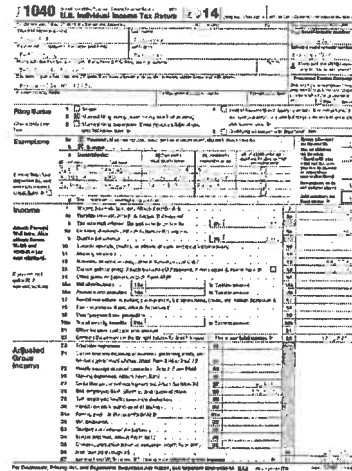


If You Want Your Child to Obtain Financial Aid for College or have them be able to apply for **The RCC Promise Program**, You Must Complete This Form and Have Your Child Return it to School for the College Kick Off event on Wednesday, Oct. 30<sup>th</sup>. Your student needs this information along with their FSAID to File for Financial Aid.

To apply for the FAFSA or Dream Act your **parent or parents must provide:**

- 2018 federal Income Tax form (1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ)
- Total amount of money in checking and savings accounts \$ \_\_\_\_\_
