



Focused Note Taking: The CORNELL WAY

Note-Taking

- Step 1: Create Format- Set up the paper with an Essential Question at the top.
- Step 2: Organize Notes- Take notes in chunks, paraphrasing, using abbreviations.

Note-Making

- Step 3: **R**eview and Revise- Go back and fill in missing information and use the textbook or other resources to improve your notes.
- Step 4: Note Key Ideas- Create questions on the left whose answers are the chunk of notes.
- Step 5: **E**xchange Ideas- Exchange notes with another student and update what you've written.

Note-Interacting

- Step 6: Link Learning- Write a summary at the end of your notes. The summary should answer the Essential Question and each of the questions you wrote.
- Step 7: Learning Tool- Use the notes as a study/review tool. Fold the paper and answer your own questions, get in circles and read summaries aloud, etc.

Note-Reflecting

- Step 8: Provide Written Feedback- Teacher provides feedback on the quality of the notes.
- Step 9: Address Feedback- Students respond to the feedback and fix any deficiencies.
- Step 10: Reflect on Your Learning- At the end of each unit, complete a reflection on the content of the notes from the unit.
