1. Approve minutes from February 28, 2022 - Anderson made a motion to approve minutes as drafted. Seconded by Cabeza and all were in favor- minutes approved.

1. Budget Reports by Funding Source - Cabeza reviewed balances left Title 1 - 10,061 and LCFF LI 6,368.
2. School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA)
 - Review activities for family engagement goal from last meeting and revise as needed - council discussed the idea of adding a kick off event at the beginning of next year to increase parent involvement again.
 - Monitor implementation of the SPSA goals/actions : focus on last goal of literacy, present data and brainstorm activities for goal . - Cabeza reviewed lready data from last year and Fall of this year showing there had not been growth, She also reviewed ELPAC testing scores and lack of growth. Council discussed the following ideas to include in the SPSA for the literacy goal - incentives and materials for the library, funds for book fair events, funds for tech apps for reading, funds for reading posters for teacher classrooms, funds for EL library materials, funds for Sped library materials, funds for library events and incentives for community events for reading. Cabeza discussed keeping funds for training staff in AVID, monthly DLIQ workshops and learning walks as

well as funds for seal of biliteracy events, student recognition.
