



A survey of the experience of Americans of African descent in America from the 1600s to 1865. The course begins with

the history of African civilizations on the coast of West Africa, moves through the rise of slavery in the Americas, the origins and developments of American ideas about race, and the formation of African American culture(s) and identities. It then culminates with emancipation at the end of the Civil War. 3 units (UC, CSU)




### MUS-23 HISTORY OF ROCK AND ROLL

A comprehensive study of rock and roll music from its origins to the present with emphasis on the historical, musical, and sociological influences. Study includes listening to music and identifying stylistic trends and influential artists. 3 Units (UC, CSU)



#### AHS-6 ART APPRECIATION

An introductory course for the non-art major. The creative process and the diversity of style, technique and media, evident in various art forms throughout history and culture. Students may not receive credit for both AHS-6 and AHS-6H. 54 hours lecture. 3 Units (UC, CSU)



## HIS-31 INTRODUCTION TO CHICANA/O/X STUDIES

Introduction to the study of the Chicana/o/x people, including their history, identity, and culture. Key moments in the history of the Chicana/o/x population are highlighted from the preColumbian and Spanish colonial periods to the present. Emphasis is placed on analyzing the complexity and diversity of the culture and identity of the Chicana/o/x people, with focus on race and ethnicity, class, citizenship, gender, sexuality, and region. 3 Units (UC, CSU)
