### COMPLETE THE PARENT AUTHORIZATION FORM

### APPLY TO RIVERSIDE CITY COLLEGE



If you're interested in starting your educational journey with the Dual Enrollment program, go to <a href="www.rcc.edu">www.rcc.edu</a> and submit an application. Processing your application takes one to two business days. After processing, you will receive a welcome email containing a student ID number, student email address and instructions for <a href="https://www.mcc.edu">MyPortal</a>.

### RECEIVE CONFIRMATION EMAIL FROM RCC DUAL ENROLLMENT

Once you have submitted your your parent authorization form, you will receive a confirmation email from RCC's Dual Enrollment. The email will confirm that you are cleared for registration. Follow the instructions provided to log into <a href="MyPortal">MyPortal</a> and Register for classes



## LOG INTO MYPORTAL



Sign in using YOUR RCCD student email address. The default password is the first initial of your first name in uppercase and the first initial of your last name in lowercase with your six-digit date of birth.

#### REGISTER FOR CLASSES

Register for classes using  $\underline{\mathsf{MyPortal}}$ . Speak to your guidance counselor if you are not sure which class to register for.
