Mr. Schwandt succeeds Mrs. Julie A. Moreno. Mr. Schwandt was re-elected this past November and is beginning his third term on the Board.

Mrs. Carolyn M. Wilson was elected Vice President. Ms. Georgina Ramirez was elected Clerk.

During the proceedings, Mrs. Moreno was recognized for her outstanding leadership in 2022. Mrs. Moreno led the District through the challenging post-COVID era. Mrs. Moreno was re-elected this past November and is beginning her third term.

Additionally, Ms. Georgina Ramirez was sworn in for her first term as a member of the Alvord Unified School District Board of Education. Ms. Ramirez was elected to represent Trustee Area 1. She replaces Dr. Joanna Dorado, who chose not to pursue a second term. Dr. Dorado was recognized for her contributions to the District during the November 17, 2022 Regular Meeting of the Board of Education.
