HOMEWORK POLICY

All homework is to be completed by all pupils. Failure to do so results in poor assessment scores, as well as a poor grade point average for the academic area(s).

Homework is assigned for the week on the first day of the week. Students are also responsible for completing homework assignments that may be given by other instructors. Occasionally, assignments are given for the weekend. However, most (but not all) weekend assignments simply entail studying.

Homework should take 45 minutes to 60 minutes to complete.

Please be advised that some pupils may require additional time to complete assignments.

- *⇒* Return your homework on time. (usually due on the first day of the school week unless otherwise noted)
