

ADULT EDUCATION CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT



The Adult Education Concurrent Enrollment Program at **Riverside City College** allows high school diploma, or equivalency certificate, adult school students to benefit from **free college credit classes!**

Eligibility Requirements

Adult school students actively participating in a high school diploma or equivalency certificate, may enroll in credit classes at **Riverside City College**, tuition-free. **Students are required to pay a Health Fee, a Student Services Fee, and a Transportation Fee during each term they attend. All costs such as course materials, textbooks, and parking permits are to be paid by the student as well.**

Requirements:

1. Be enrolled in an adult education program completing a high school diploma or equivalency certificate (GED, Spanish GED, or HiSET).
2. Complete the RCC Online Admission Application.
3. Provide proof of enrollment in an adult education program; high school diploma or equivalency certificate (GED, Spanish GED, or HiSET).
4. Complete the RCC Adult Education Concurrent Enrollment School Approval Form.

Maximum Units:

- 11 units during the fall/spring semester
- 5 units during the summer/winter semester
 - **Restricted Courses - all Kinesiology (KIN) courses**

Registration:

- Students must wait until the first day of the term to officially register.
