ADULT EDUCATION CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT





The Adult Education Concurrent Enrollment Program at Riverside City College allows high school diploma, or equivalency certificate, adult school students to benefit from free college credit classes!

Eligibility Requirements

Adult school students actively participating in a high school diploma or equivalency certificate, may enroll in credit classes at **Riverside City College**, tuition-free. *Students are required to pay a Health Fee, a Student Services Fee, and a Transportation Fee during each term they attend. All costs such as course materials, textbooks, and parking permits are to be paid by the student as well.*

Requirements:

- 1. Be enrolled in an adult education program completing a high school diploma or equivalency certificate (GED, Spanish GED, or HiSET).
- 2. Complete the RCC Online Admission Application.
- 3. Provide proof of enrollment in an adult education program; high school diploma or equivalency certificate (GED, Spanish GED, or HiSET).
- 4. Complete the RCC Adult Education Concurrent Enrollment School Approval Form.

Maximum Units:

- 11 units during the fall/spring semester
- 5 units during the summer/winter semester
 - Restricted Courses all Kinesiology (KIN) courses

Registration:

• Students must wait until the first day of the term to officially register.
