Reading 10 Things

1. Answer text dependent questions.
2. Identify and describe the main idea and details.
3. Literature and informational retell using 6-frame or Frayer-type model.
4. Recognize and decode words with digraphs, diphthong, vowel teams, and r-controlled vowels.
5. High frequency words
6. Exposure to 2nd grade phonics patterns.
7. Fluently read Lexile 425.

Writing 10 Things

1. Produce a complete sentence with 6-7 words with a subject and a predicate.
2. Produce a topic sentence for narrative, opinion, and informative writing.
3. Use CUPS for editing.
4. Produce proper letter formations, use correct spacing, and developmentally appropriate writing structure.

Math 10 Things

1. Count within 120.
2. Understand place value of two digit numbers.
3. Add and subtract to 99 without regrouping.
4. Word problem attach- read, draw, write (numbers and words)
5. Measure with non-standard tools.
6. Analog clock (half hour, hour, know the hands)
7. Make a graph from data and answer questions.
8. Name of 2D and 3D shapes.
9. Exposure to coins (names, values, skip counting).
