The top ten priority standards in the areas of reading, writing, and math.

Reading 10 Things

- 1. Read at a Lexile 645 and 90 correct words per minute
- Retell with setting, plot, sequence of events, and character point of view/ perspective
- 3. Identify the main idea and key details
- 4. Respond to questions such as 5 W's
- 5. Develop vocabulary with homophones, synonyms, antonyms, and multiple meaning words
- 6. Use context clues to determine the meaning of unknown words
- 7. Imagery, test to visual connections
- 8. Identify cause and effect relationships
- 9. High frequency words with automaticity in isolation and context

Writing 10 Things

- Produce and complete sentences including 7-8 words with a subject and a predicate
- 2. Produce multiple sentences on a topic for narrative, opinion, and informative writing
- 3. Use graphic organizer to create a paragraph
- 4. Use sequential and transition words as appropriate
- 5. Use CUPS to revise writing
- 6. Introduction to keyboarding skills to type sentences.

Math 10 Things

- 1. Addition and subtraction up to 999 with regrouping (0)
- Place value up to 1,000- read and write numbers with expanded form and number names
- 3. Multi-step word problems (comparison)
- 4. Area and arrays up to 12 x 12 in multiplication, number, and word form
- 5. Know multiplication is repeated addition, division is repeated subtraction, addition and subtraction are opposites.
- 6. Measure inches, feet, yards, millimeter, centimeter, meter, and estimation
- Create and read graphs to make comparisons and answer questions
- 8. Analog and digital time to nearest five minutes, am and pm.
- 9. Money and coin combination and counting dollars and coins together.
- 10. Fractions: part of a whole, denominator is the numbers of items, numerator is the number of items used ($\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{3}$, $\frac{3}{4}$)
- 11.2D and 3D shapes, classify by vertices, compare shapes, sides, faces, etc.
