Reading 10 Things

- 1. Literary story elements & character traits
- Author's message (theme, recount stories)
- 3. Information text features: graphs, pictures, maps
- 4. Informational sequencing (historical events, timeline of events, cause & effect)
- 5. Determine main & idea
- 6. Compare & contrast 2 sources/text
- 7. Reading strategies-context clues, inferencing
- 8. Decoding skills
- 9. Reading stamina
- 10. Ask and answer questions

Writing 10 Things

- 1. Independently write paragraphs (informational, opinion, narrative)
- 2. Informational and opinion: topic sentence, three details with multiple reasons/ examples, and conclusion.
- 3. Narrative: beginning, middle, end, should contain problem/ solution, sequencing of events, character development
- 4. Cite evidence (sorting evidence based on category and source)
- 5. Write daily
- 6. keyboarding/typing skills
- 7. Research projects

Math 10 Things

- 1. Multiplication and division: fluency to 144
- 2. Multiplication and division: strategies and properties
- 3. Place value (millions) and rounding to the nearest thousands
- 4. Area of more than one rectangle or square combined
- 5. Perimeter of any polygon
- 6. Attributes of polygons with quadrilateral focus
- 7. Word problems (multi-step)
- 8. Graphing data: bar graphs, pictographs, and line plots
- 9. Fractions: on a number line, ordering, comparing, equivalent fractions, and whole numbers as a fraction
- 10. Measuring to the nearest ¼ of an inch
- 11. Elapsed time

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
