## Reading 10 Things

1. Infer, explain, and refer to text
2. Analyze story elements
3. Comprehend grade-level informational and literature texts
4. Determine main ideas and details from texts
5. Recognize perspective of characters
6. Cite textual evidence
7. Adhere to text structure
8. Analyze multiple accounts of the same event
9. Determine the theme
10. Identify the author's purpose

## Writing 10 Things

1. Recognize and use all sentences structures
2. Identify run-ons. Compound, sentence fragments, and complete sentences
3. Write in complete sentences using adjective
4. Produce multi-paragraph essays
5. Use appropriate conventions when writing
6. Revise and edit own writing
7. Publish essays with keyboarding skills

## Math 10 Things

1. Add and subtract fractions with like and unlike denominators
2. Multiply and divide decimals
3. Write and read numbers to the billions
4. Compare whole numbers and partial numbers to identify value
5. Round, estimate, and justify multi-digit whole and partial numbers
6. Compute expressions using order of operations
7. Conversion of unit measurement in weight, capacity, and length
8. Collaboration to solve real world problems using the four operations
9. Recognize when to use formulas for measurement
10. Graph and label points on a coordinate plane
