Description: The AACelerated Assessment & Implementation Certificate Course is an accelerated virtual course that prepares participants to assess students with complex communication needs who may benefit from augmentative and alternative communication (AAC). The course will provide content in multiple synchronous class sessions with individual coaching through the assessment process for all participants. Participants will be required to complete one AAC assessment on a student of their choice, where feedback will be provided. A completed assessment must adhere to the class provided AAC assessment report template requirements to receive a passing grade. Upon completion of the report, participants will receive a certificate of completion for 30 hours. Students will also have the option of earning 3.0 Graduate Level PDUs which will include mentoring and coaching, totaling 45 hours of credit. *(This course does not cover assistive technology.)*

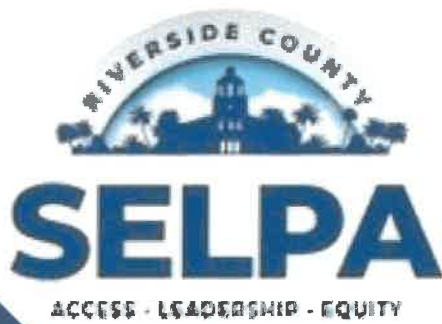

Shipping Methods

The infection risk associated with COVID-19 has influenced those working in community, school and healthcare settings alike to take measures to limit close interaction between individuals. Health screening interactions such as vision screening should be performed while protecting the health and safety of all individuals and, while there are not yet guidelines specific for vision screening, the general principles of infection prevention are important to understand.
