III. Discussion/Information/Training

- 1. School Report: Promenade Elementary School Mr. Francisco Gonzalez, Principal
- Mr. Gonzalez presented the following information about Promenade Elementary School:
- Promenade's Engagement Framework encompasses parents and community, students, teachers and staff. Some activities have been suspended during school closures due to the COVID-19.
- Parents and community engage through events such as Since Night, Panther Parent Workshops, Vehicle Day, Career Day, and Daily Volunteers.
- Students engage through evening events, afterschool tutoring and activities during the school day such as assemblies, attendance incentives and the Panther Store.
- Teachers and staff are engaged through professional development. Teachers show their support by attending evening events and Professional Growth events and enhancing current practices.
- There are 15 ethnicities/races represented at Promenade.
- English Learner funds are effectively used to pay for Professional Development, supplemental materials and supplies (ex. devices) and to provide student support through Bilingual Instructional Assistants.
- 2. Needs Assessment: What services and support do our counselors provide for our EL students? Mr. Juan Chavez

Mr. Chavez informed parents about the support counselors provide to EL students. Counselors provide:

• Support through making them feel welcome, inviting them to clubs and programs and going over graduation requirements with them.

- Encouragement through engaging events such as ELD Class presentations, Soccer Tuesdays and Tutoring Wednesdays.
- Collaboration with ELD and sheltered teachers by arranging targeted college and career presentations and other workshops.
- 3. Title III Overview Ms. Martha Martinez

Ms. Martinez provided an overview of the purpose and use of Title III funds. Member input will be collected at the next meeting.

4. Distance Learning Resources for Parents and Students – Dr. Emily Devor

Dr. Emily Devor, Director III, Elementary Education, began by thanking all members for helping their children during the school closures. She spoke about the importance of keeping an ongoing communication with teachers through email and/or technology applications such as Class Dojo or Seesaw. She shared with parents how to access the distance learning resources posted on the district's website (Alvordschools.org>Departments>Educational Services). She mentioned how these resources are available to all families in helping with academics and social-emotional supports.
