THE COMMUNITY

Amityville is a community with a population of 9,500 located in the southwestern corner of Suffolk County on Long Island. In addition to a senior high school, the public school system includes three elementary and one middle school with a total district enrollment of 2,916 and a professional staff of 640.

THE SCHOOL

Amityville Memorial High School is a four year comprehensive public high school. The enrollment at the high school was approximately 1,009 including 193 graduating students in the senior class of 2022. Counselor/student ratio is 1:336, with counselors assigned to the same students from ninth through twelfth grade. The CEEB Code is 330-155.

CURRICULUM INFORMATION

Advanced Placement courses are offered in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, English Composition/Literature, Calculus, Spanish, Research, Seminar, World History, United States History, Psychology, Studio in Art, Computer, and Government. College credit courses are offered in Calculus, and Forensic Science through Syracuse University Project Advance Program and College Spanish.
