ASA parent and PACK member, Jennifer Stevens, gave an update from the PACK:

- The PACK had a meeting this morning and closed the books for the school year and also nominated the PACK members which will remain the same.
- The last day of school Tailgate party went well and was a great event. They had a lot of participation and everyone seemed to have fun.
- Some PACK members gave campus tours for future ASA families and enjoyed it and hope to be included in any future ones.
- The PACK will be putting committees together to organize different events throughout the coming year. This should help relieve the PACK members from taking on so much responsibility as well as help bring in more family participation.
- A survey was sent out to parents for input. Some parents requested that the meetings take place later in the day, so the PACK decided that beginning July 17th that every third Wednesday they'll have evening meetings. The executive board will meet from 6:00 pm to 6:30 pm then will have an open session from 6:30 pm to 7:00 pm.
- The PACK is still working on getting the water fountains as well as the freezer for ice cream sales. They're also planning on purchasing more spirit wear, tables, carts, and a dolly.

2. CEO's Report

Dr. Cognetta gave an update:

- He thanked the PACK for helping with the tours and felt that having current ASA parents take future ASA parents on tours brings a lot of credibility to them.
- Dr. Cognetta thanked the renewal committee on help with the Charter Petition.
 He recently attended a renewal webinar and an oversight workshop facilitated
 by FCMAT. We're working with Charter Impact to be sure the finances are
 detailed within the petition. This information will be presented to the board
 members at the next board meeting.
- He gave a shout out to Meredith King for all she did for ASA's first year. He thanked her and said he'll miss her.
- Dr. Cognetta acknowledged that this is member Melanie Choi's last meeting and congratulated her and thanked her for all she's done.
- Dr. Cognetta said Admin and the Office Staff had a meeting to reflect on the year. He's happy with the communication and professionalism within the office. Targets have been set for the coming year. He said that the office is a welcoming atmosphere and would like to keep it that way but at the same time it's a professional atmosphere where a lot of confidential issues are handled and discussed. We're trying to reach the balance of the community feeling welcome but at the same time being able to handle our responsibilities in a professional and confidential manner. Our goal is to keep it warm and inviting but at the same time for the community to remember that it's not a social gathering spot.

Tammy Lohoff gave a teacher's report:

 Mrs. Lohoff thanked the Meredith King for her help all year and expressed her appreciation.

- She was very happy with the way the 8th grade promotion went. She said it was
 one of the nicest events she's been to in the history of Charter schools. She also
 acknowledged how much work Heather Peery and Jennifer Stevens did to make it
 happen.
- The last day of school Tailgate party went really well and she thanked the PACK for all their work in organizing it.
- Mrs. Lohoff has been involved in the interview process for some teachers and has been included in what the upcoming Professional Development meetings will be like.
- Recently a few ASA teachers along with Dr. Moreno had a Book Club Meeting to discuss standards-based learning.

Dr. Cognetta continued:

- Tomorrow the team will be meeting to round out course descriptions regarding curriculum and instruction for the middle school program. They've been in touch with a secondary department with CVUSD to be sure our courses are aligned nicely with their high schools.
- Our CAASPP testing is complete now that the school year is over, and preliminary data is coming in and from the information we have now it's looking encouraging considering we're a first-year school. Details will be out and presented soon. He said that most families already have access to their student's test scores within the Illuminate Parent Portal as the state is dealing with delays with a couple of grade levels.
- Dr. Cognetta met with the CVUSD charter coordinator, Lori Warner, in which
 they both attended a workshop for oversight. She was very pleasant, encouraging,
 and positive and they look forward to working together. When she officially starts
 he'll get her up to speed with the renewal process and will get her insight to know
 what CVUSD would like to see during the process.
- At the next board meeting we'll have additional policies for the board to review including a resolution on how we want to treat PTO.
- We received the additional \$50,000 from the federal start-up grant. He said that the funds from this year will be able to roll over to next year which is a big deal considering that this is a reimbursement grant (he said Meredith can give more info on that if needed).
