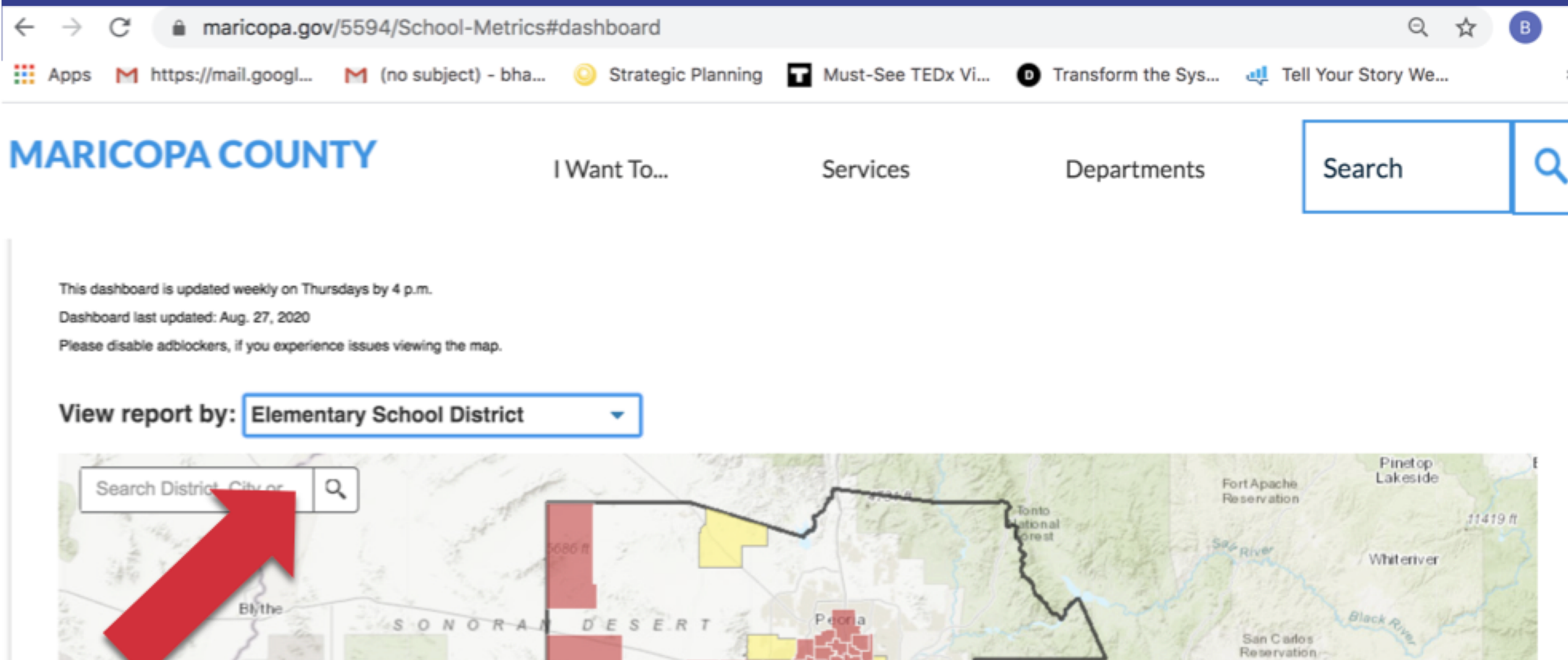

While many schools begin the academic year in distance-learning environments, here are some things schools can do to support students and families:

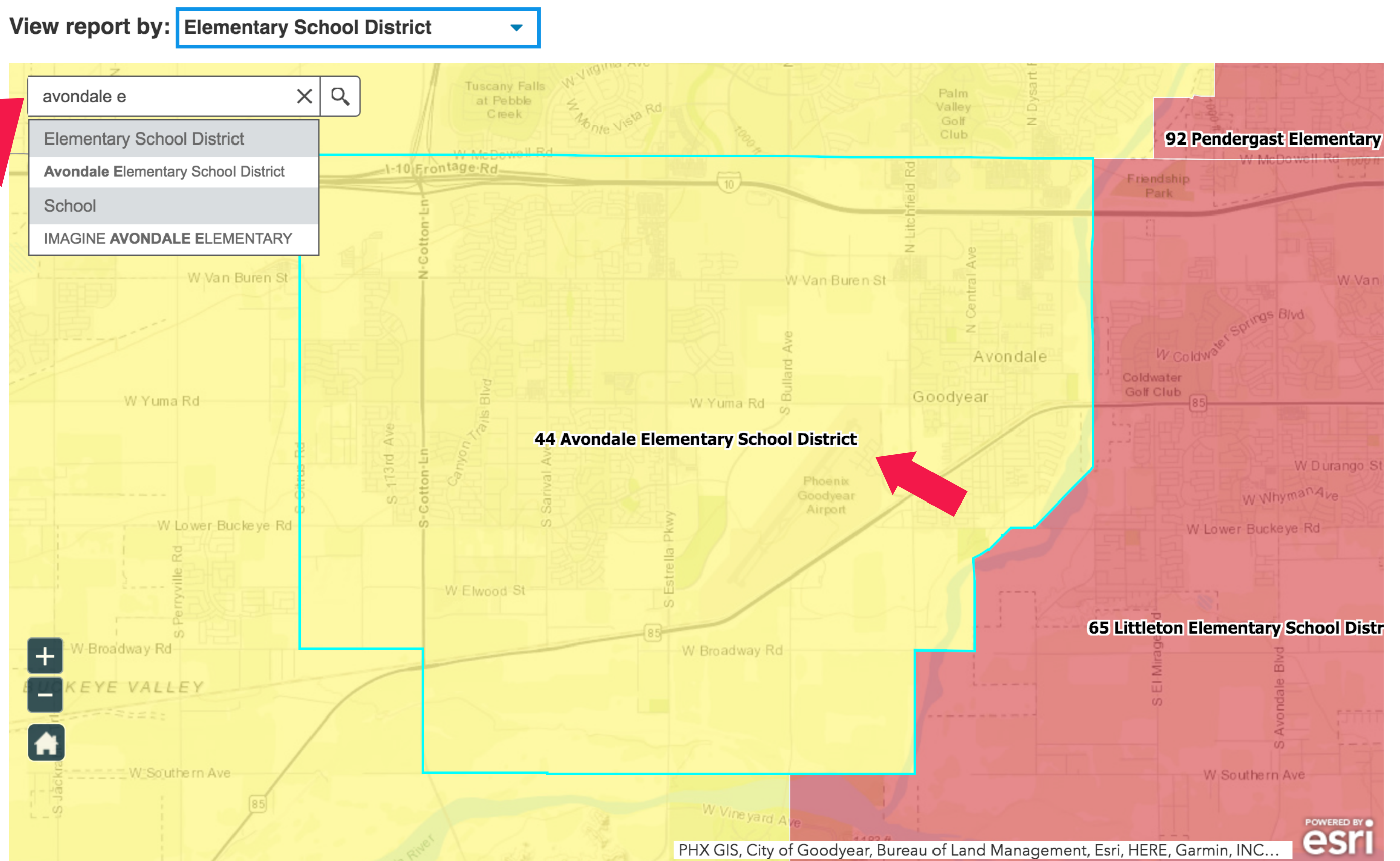
- Ensure parents/guardians have a plan to designate a caregiver for a sick child(ren) if parents/guardians can't stay home.
