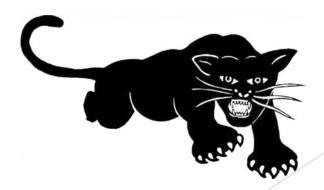

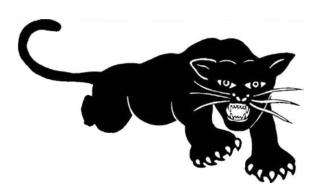

# Key Factors/Challenges in the 2019/2020 Budget:

- ▶ Bond Debt We must now budget to pay down principle as well as pay interest on the 2013 Bond Renewal Project at a cost of \$1,555,000 (principle) & \$642,275 (interest).
- ► State Aid Funding We await the final dollar amount from Albany on or about April 1, 2019.
- ► The State Aid-Increase in Foundation Aid is only \$13,704 (.25% of 1%).
