

Voter Registration and General Information

The 2019-2020 Budget Vote and Trustee Election will be held on Tuesday, May 21, 2019.

Voting hours are from 6:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.

Voting will take place in the East Gymnasium of the Babylon Junior-Senior High School, 50 Railroad Avenue, Babylon, NY. The East Gymnasium entrance is located on Grove Place.

VOTER REGISTRATION

Continuous voter registration is available in the office of the District Clerk from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, when school is in session, up to and including May 16, 2019. For more information, contact the District Clerk at 631-893-7925. Residents who have voted or registered at any Annual or Special School District Meeting or election held within the last four (4) years, or have voted at a general election or been registered with the Board of Elections of Suffolk County within the last four (4) years, are eligible to vote.

If you would like to register to vote, you must

- Be a citizen of the United States;
- Be 18 years of age or over;
- Be a resident of the Babylon School District for at least 30 days prior to the voting date.

Absentee Ballot Application

An application for an absentee ballot must be received by the District Clerk at least seven days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election if the ballot is to be issued to the voter in person.

Absentee Ballot Deadline

No absentee voter's ballot will be counted unless it is received in the office of the District Clerk, 50 Railroad Avenue, Babylon, NY 11702 by 5:00 p.m. on the day of the election.
