



## 2023-2024 Scholarship Timeline

1. Application on the HSF website.
2. Application Deadline April 20, 2023.
3. Applications reviewed for eligibility and compliance with instructions
4. Applicants notified of their status.
5. Finalists provide supplemental information.
6. Scholarships awarded late May, 2023.
7. Finalists eligible for but not awarded a scholarship after supplemental information is processed will receive \$2,000.

## Eligibility Requirements

1. Must be a citizen of the United States.
2. Must attend a traditional public high school located in the U.S. that is governed by a school district.
3. Must have a 3.50 cumulative grade point average.
4. Must enroll at an eligible four-year college or university following high school graduation.
5. Must maintain a four year or less graduation Schedule in college.
6. Must work 240 hours each year from January 1 until commencement of the fall semester in college. Work can be performed at recipient discretion.
7. Applicant’s Gross Household Income reported for 2021 Federal Income Tax Purposes must not have exceeded \$85,000.
8. Must provide the FAFSA SAR showing the EFC.
9. Must apply for Federal and State grants if eligible.
10. Must not have a felony conviction.

The intended recipient of a Hagan Scholarship is a high-achieving goal driven student having a financial need in order to attend college.

## Hagan Scholarship Foundation

The Hagan Scholarship is a nationwide need-based merit scholarship, providing recipients with the opportunity to graduate college debt-free. The scholarship provides up to \$7,500 each semester for up to eight (8) consecutive semesters.

Recipients graduating college while in the Hagan Scholarship Program can apply for a Hagan Graduate Scholarship, good for up to four (4) additional consecutive semesters receiving up to \$7,500 each semester.

Free workshops, Free Schwab Brokerage Accounts and Free Study Abroad provide recipients with a practical understanding of important life skills not typically covered in the school curriculum. Hagan Scholars have attended 429 colleges and universities located in 48 states.

Applicants must attend a traditional public high school governed by a school district. Applicant’s Gross Household Income reported for 2021 Federal Income Tax Purposes must not have exceeded \$85,000.
