

## 2023-2024 Scholarship Timeline

- 1. Application on the HSF website.
- 2. Application Deadline April 20, 2023.
- 3. Applications reviewed for eligibility and compliance with instructions
- 4. Applicants notified of their status.
- 5. Finalists provide supplemental information.
- 6. Scholarships awarded late May, 2023.
- 7. Finalists eligible for but not awarded a scholarship after supplemental information is processed will receive \$2,000.

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- 1. Must be a citizen of the United States.
- 2. Must attend a traditional public high school located in the U.S. that is governed by a school district.
- 3. Must have a 3.50 cumulative grade point average.
- 4. Must enroll at an eligible four-year college or university following high school graduation.
- 5. Must maintain a four year or less graduation Schedule in college.
- 6. Must work 240 hours each year from January 1 until commencement of the fall semester in college. Work can be performed at recipient discretion.
- 7. Applicant's Gross Household Income reported for 2021 Federal Income Tax Purposes must not have exceeded \$85,000.
- 8. Must provide the FAFSA SAR showing the EFC.
- 9. Must apply for Federal and State grants if eligible.
- 10. Must not have a felony conviction.

The intended recipient of a Hagan Scholarship is a high-achieving goal driven student having a financial need in order to attend college.

## Hagan Scholarship Foundation

The Hagan Scholarship is a nationwide need-based merit scholarship, providing recipients with the opportunity to graduate college debt-free. The scholarship provides up to \$7,500 each semester for up to eight (8) consecutive semesters.

Recipients graduating college while in the Hagan Scholarship Program can apply for a Hagan Graduate Scholarship, good for up to four (4) additional consecutive semesters receiving up to \$7,500 each semester.

Free workshops, Free Schwab Brokerage Accounts and Free Study Abroad provide recipients with a practical understanding of important life skills not typically covered in the school curriculum. Hagan Scholars have attended 429 colleges and universities located in 48 states.

Applicants must attend a traditional public high school governed by a school district. Applicant's Gross Household Income reported for 2021 Federal Income Tax Purposes must not have exceeded \$85,000.
