To be eligible, student must be a high school senior (class of 2023) and plan on attending a full-time course of undergraduate study as a freshman at a university, college, community college or recognized vocational school. One entry per person. If selected, student is required to provide proof of acceptance into the school they will be attending. On Friday, April 28, 2023, eleven (11) names will be randomly drawn. Of those eleven, the first three (3) names randomly drawn will each win a \$10,000 Award. \$10,000 Scholarship recipients will be awarded \$2,500 per year for four years and proof of attendance each year will be mandatory before award is given. The remaining eight (8) names selected will each win a \$2,500 Scholarship. All winners will be notified via mail, email or phone using the contact information provided at the time of entry, and a list of recipients will be published in the Island Quarterly newsletter, on the Island website, as well as displayed in our branch offices. Acceptance of the Scholarship shall constitute winner's consent for ISLAND FEDERAL to use winner's name and photograph for advertising and promotional purposes without further compensation. Senior picture required from winners. 1A debit card and checking account is required, however there is NO minimum balance needed to open or maintain the account.
