In grade 5, three critical areas are focused on:

- (1) Developing fluency with addition and subtraction of fractions, and developing understanding of the multiplication of fractions
- (2) Extending division to 2-digit divisors, integrating decimal fractions into the place value system and developing understanding of operations with decimals to hundredths, and developing fluency with whole number and decimal operations
- (3) Developing an understanding of volume as an attribute of 3D space.
