INSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS

A minimum of twenty-four (24) clock hours of 'Behind the Wheel' and 'In Car Observation' instruction is required.

- A. Driving instruction must include a minimum of six (6) clock hours of 'Behind-the-Wheel' driving AND a minimum of six (6) clock hours of 'In Car Observation.'
- B. The remaining twelve (12) hours of instruction must be a combination of additional 'Behind-the-Wheel' instruction and 'In Car Observation.'
- C. Driving instruction must complete all 16 sessions/lessons of the provided driving curriculum.

DMV GLOSSARY OF TERMS

DRIVING INSTRUCTION: Behind-the-Wheel and In-Car Observation

- Behind The Wheel Instruction: The portion of the driver education instruction where the enrollee is actually seated behind the wheel of a vehicle, operating it either in real or simulated traffic situations, through the direct guidance of an approved Driver & Traffic Education teacher (MV-283 card holder) or driving school instructor (MV 524 card holder).
- In Car Observation: The time an enrollee in a driver education course spends in the vehicle, under the direct guidance of an approved driver education teacher/instructor, observing another <u>driver</u> operate the controls of the vehicle.
