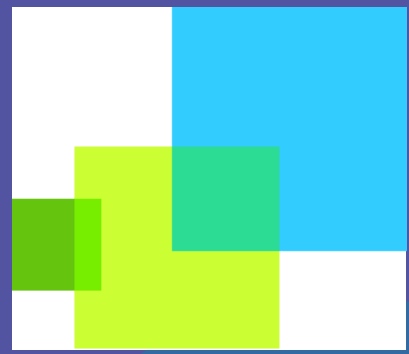
Who we are:
