BISD enrolled students

Alternative Learning Experience Laws(ALE) mandate

- Parent is the primary instructor in home-centered setting supported by Mosaic teacher/academic advisor.
- Student attends on-campus classes, field trips and workshops
- Parent creates Written Student Learning Plan (WSLP) with an academic advisor to support academic goals, curriculum, and learning targets.
- Program provides BISD approved curriculum and materials; parent may choose other resource options as well that are approved by Advisor to support goals.
- Parent consults with Certificated Advisor monthly to discuss progress, learning goals, academic outcomes, and supports.
- Program offers all state and district assessments and screeners (FastBridge, SBA, etc)

On-campus Enrichment Classes

- Traditionally MOSAIC has offered on-campus enrichment classes for all students, ALE and BEL, to attend.
- Typically classes will be scheduled during the week
 1-2 part days and are designated by grade bands
- 2022-23 Enrichment TBD based on enrollment and staff schedules.
