

2022-2023 Course Syllabus for THEATRE

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Course Description: This course is designed for students to explore all areas of theatre and performance. We will cover proper stage terms, audience etiquette, theatre history, the production staff, vocal production, the plot diagram, playwriting, vocal warm up techniques, monologue and scene performances, theatre games, and more!

This IS a performance based class. ALL students, regardless of their interests in theatre arts, will be required to do performances in class both individually and with partners.

Tests and Grades

<p>Grading: A=90-100 B=80-89 C=70-79 D=65-69 F=below 65 I=incomplete Grading follows the policies of Biloxi Public Schools. A mid-term progress report and a report card following the end of each term are issued.</p>

Grades: Grades are based on classroom activities, paper/pencil tests, and performances/presentations. Performances and presentations are graded using a rubric which we build upon for each performance assessment. Since all of my grades average to 90%, I will enter performance grades twice to weight them as "tests"

These activities and assessments will be 90% of the term average.

Term Exam: The term exam is 10% of the term average

Homework/Assignments/Projects: Students are highly encouraged to read fiction/non-fiction text every night. Explore texts. Read scripts. Watch plays. Attend live theatre events!

Often, students will need to work on saying/performing, and/or memorizing their lines as homework.
