ELIGIBILITY: -

- · High school seniors who reside in counties of:
 - o California Alameda, Contra Costa, Los Angeles, Marin, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, San Francisco and San Mateo
 - o New York Bronx, Kings, Nassau, New York, Putnam, Queens, Richmond, Rockland, Suffolk and Westchester
 - New Jersey Passaic, Bergen and Hudson
 - Texas Harris, Fort Bend, Brazoria, Montgomery, and Galveston
- Plan to attend a U.S. Accredited 4-Year College/University or a Community College and will be enrolled as a freshman in the Fall of 2024 (if selected, must submit college acceptance letter for verification)
- A minimum cumulative unweighted high school GPA of 3.0
- A household income at or below the Low Income Level (must be able to show 2022 or 2023 tax return) should applicant be selected for award)
- Open to ALL MAJORS and there is NO ETHNICITY REQUIREMENT
- Employees of Preferred Bank and their immediate family members are NOT eligible to apply

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Application Form
- Recommender Form from a Community Service Advisor
- High School Transcript

The scholarship awards will only be used to cover the cost of tuition for attending a college/university. What is considered cost of tuition varies by institution.
