Five \$5,000 Scholarships Available for High School Seniors Planning to Attend a University/College in the U.S. in the Fall of 2024

### Scholarship Information

The Robin-Hwajin Yoon Kim Foundation which supports education, the underprivileged, and positive social impact initiatives has established 'Kao Kalia Yang Scholarship' to help economically-challenged Hmong American youth fulfill their dreams of obtaining higher education. The scholarship is open to high school seniors planning to attend college in the Fall of 2024. If selected, \$5,000 will be awarded each year for up to four years (upon meeting renewal requirements).

#### Deadline

Monday, April 15, 2024 — 11:59pm (PDT)

#### Eligibility

- Blood descendants of Hmong race or ethnically identified as Hmong American (with a citizenship or as a permanent resident.)
- High school senior residing in the United States
- Plan to attend a University or Community College as a 1st year student in Fall 2024 (If selected, must submit college acceptance letter for verification.)
- Have a minimum cumulative unweighted high school GPA of 2.8
- Have a household income at or below the Federal/State/County Low Income Level (Must be able to show 2022 or 2023 tax return should applicant be selected for award.)
- The scholarship is open to ALL MAJORS

#### Application Requirements

- Application Form
- Recommender Form
- Official High School Transcript
- Online interview (to be scheduled if selected as a finalist)

The scholarship awards will only be used to cover the cost of attending a University or College. What is considered cost of attendance varies by institution.
