

To All Stakeholders:

A Participation Rate Improvement Plan (PRIP) is required when, for two consecutive years, the same accountability subgroup has a participation rate on either of the State assessments

- *NYS ELA, Math, and Science Assessment Participation rates were below 95%;*
- *The 2017-18 school year participation rate was lower than the 2016-17 participation rate and the 2018-19 school year participation rate was lower than the 2017-18 participation rate; and*
- *The 2017-18 and 2018-19 school year Weighted Average Achievement Level for elementary/middle schools or the Composite Performance Level for high schools was below Level 3.*

We have developed the following plan aimed to address the Participation Rate and increase our district percentages.



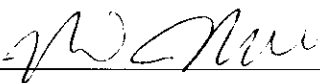

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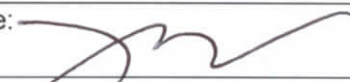

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#### IV. NEW BUSINESS

- 1) **Be it resolved** by Board of Education of the Bridgehampton UFSD that Retention and Disposition Scheduled for New York Local Government Records (LGS-1), issued pursuant to Article 57-A of the Arts and Cultural Affairs Law, and contained legal minimum retention periods for local government records, is hereby adopted for use by all officers in legally disposing of valueless records listed therein.

**Be it further resolved**, that in accordance with Article 57-A:

- a) Only those records will be disposed of that are described in Retention and Disposition Schedule for New York Local Government Records (LGS-1), after they have met the minimum retention periods described therein;
- b) Only those records will be disposed of that do not have sufficient administrative, fiscal, legal, or historical value to merit retention beyond established legal minimum periods.

**WHEREAS**, when the test administration rate is less than 95%, and when the participation rate has failed to improve for two consecutive years, the District is required to develop and adopt a participation rate improvement plan for each applicable group and/or subgroup; and

**WHEREAS**, the District has determined that a participation rate improvement plan is required for (i) all students, (ii) economically disadvantaged students, and (iii) Hispanic students.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Education of the Bridgehampton UFSD hereby adopts the following plans: (i) 2020-21 Participation Rate Improvement Plan – Hispanic, (ii) 2020-21 Participation Rate Improvement Plan – Economically Disadvantages, and (iii) 2020-21 Participation Rate Improvement Plan – All Students.
