O The Bridgehampton Counseling Plan is a reflection of the Part 100 Regulations of the Commissioner of the New York State Education Department (Part 100.2, section j) guidelines and the mission of the Bridgehampton Union Free School District. The primary purpose of these guidelines is to establish and maintain a school counseling program that fosters challenging academics, social/emotional support and development, and career exploration reinforcing the link between the K-12 educational program and postsecondary opportunities. The Bridgehampton School Counseling program strives to offer support and a program that aligns with the Part 100.2 regulations as well as meeting the needs of our school community.



The Role of the School Counselor at Bridgehampton School

School counselors are a vital part of the educational community. Just as our society has changed greatly over the years, so has the role of our school counselors. In the Bridgehampton School District, we are fortunate to have school counselors who work within the framework of a comprehensive school counseling program. Our counselors work with students, parents, teachers, administrators and community members to provide for the needs of all students in the areas of social/emotional, academic and career development. Following the standards of the American School Counselor Association our counselors:

- o Plan, organize and deliver the school counseling program.
- Implement the school counseling curriculum through classroom activities and lessons.
- Meet with individual students and small groups to establish goals and develop career plans.
- o Provide a confidential, safe & supportive environments for all students.
- Work with teachers, parents and administrators as advocates for our students.
- Collect and interpret data to help students make informed academic choices.
- Monitor our students' academic progress.
- Help nourish the development of social & emotional learning.
- Continually strive to grow professionally.



New York State Part 100 Regulations - School Counseling Program

The Bridgehampton School Counseling Plan aligns with the amended Part 100 of the Commissioner's Regulations.

The Program

- The Bridgehampton School District's comprehensive developmental counseling program includes all students K-12.
- o All Bridgehampton students K-12 have access to a certified school counselor.
- The Bridgehampton K-12 counseling program is designed in coordination with the teaching staff to prepare students to effectively participate in their current and future educational programs; address multiple student competencies including career/college readiness standards, academic, and social/emotional development standards.

The Services

The Bridgehampton K-12 counseling program is designed:

- 1. To prepare students to participate effectively in their current and future educational programs.
- 2. To provide information related to college and careers.
- 3. To assist students who may exhibit challenges to academic success, including but not limited to attendance or behavioral concerns.
- 4. To make referrals, where appropriate, to a properly licensed professional and/or certified pupil personnel service provider for more targeted supports.
- Certified school counselors provide students at Bridgehampton in grades 6-12 with an annual individual progress review plan, which reflects each student's educational progress and career plans; for a student with a disability, the plan shall be consistent with the student's individual education program.



For students in all grades K-12 the program includes the following activities or services:

- School counseling core curriculum instruction for the purpose of addressing student competencies related to career/college readiness, academic skills, and social/emotional development by a certified school counselor.
- Direct student services to enable students to benefit from the curriculum
 - 1. Responsive services
 - 2. Crisis response
 - 3. Individual counseling, assessment and advisement
 - 4. Group counseling
 - 5. Assisting students to develop and implement postsecondary education and career plans
 - 6. Assisting students who exhibit attendance, academic, behavioral or adjustment concerns
 - 7. Encouraging parental involvement
- o Indirect student services that enable students to benefit from their education
 - 1. Referrals to appropriately licensed or certified individuals
 - 2. Consultation and/ or collaboration with others
 - 3. Leadership, advocacy, and teaming activities

The Plan

- The Bridgehampton School has developed a district-wide & building level comprehensive school counseling plan that complies with the regulation requirements and is in accordance with the following:
- 1. Developed by or under the direction of a certified school counselor
- 2. The plan will be updated annually & a report will be presented to the board of education
- 3. The plan is filed in the district office and is available for review by any individual



- 4. The plan presents program objectives, which describe expectations of what students will learn
- 5. The plan presents a direct services chart created on the elementary, middle school, and secondary level that details specific activities or services designed to accomplish the school counseling objectives, district goals, and assessments for the year. Specifications of the staff members, student standards, and other resources are included to accomplish the objectives assigned.

Student Mindsets and Behaviors

As a result of a comprehensive counseling program, students should demonstrate the following mindsets and behaviors as outlined by ASCA:

- **Academic Development** Standards guiding school counseling programs to implement strategies and activities to support and maximize each student's ability to learn.
- Career Development Standards guiding school counseling programs to help students 1) understand the connection between school and the world of work and 2) plan for and make a successful transition from school to postsecondary education and/or the world of work and from job to job across the lifespan.
- **Social/Emotional Development** Standards guiding school counseling programs to help students manage emotions and learn and apply interpersonal skills.

School counselors use these standards to assess student growth and development, guide the development of strategies and activities and create a program that helps students achieve their highest potential. To operationalize the standards, school counselors select competencies that align with the specific standards and become the foundation for classroom lessons, small groups and activities addressing student developmental needs. The competencies directly reflect the vision, mission and goals of the comprehensive school counseling program and align with the school's academic mission.
